The Korean Cultural Center Los Angeles (Director Sang-won Jung) has announced that it will co-host the <Story Up Shorts in Los Angeles> with the CJ Cultural Foundation (Chairman Jae-hyun Lee) on August 28 at 7 PM at the center's Ari Hall.
